## GOOSANDER - SINGLE MOTHERS IN NYMPHENBURG PARK

### DESCRIPTION

"Mother & Child" - a special kind of photos.

A "Munich Special" are Goosander, which are breeding in the city area annually. Special recordings of the otherwise shy bird are possible here. Although the animals are largely used to humans, it is not easy to get good pictures. The knowledge of these birds and their behaviors are the key to success.

Even advanced and professional photographers benefit from my years of experience in photographing these birds.

Especially if someone comes from outside and is in Munich briefly, it is very helpful to have someone on site, who knows the locations and can do the research work. So you can concentrate on photography totally. I can also give you some photographic tips for sure. Since we only shoot in small groups, best results are guaranteed.

## PROCEDURE

### Morning Guiding

We meet very early (6:15) at the main entrance of Nymphenburg. I have already explored at that time the situation and with some luck we can start directly to our desired motif and exploit the morning light and the empty park. I accompany the pictures with helpful tips from years of experience with the goosander (Where is the best position, which motive is worth to be taken etc.). In between I supply "Butterbrezn" and coffee to strengthen.



At about 10:00, when the buses arrive and the light gets bad, we can discuss the results on request. I will furnish you with all necessary information and you can continue photographing on your own.

### Afternoon Guiding

For "late risers" ☺

As in the evening just before sunset beautiful photos can be taken also, I offer an afternoon variant. We meet at 16:00 at the main entrance of Nymphenburg and take pictures until about 20:00.



## NOTES

Take with you: own camera (DSLR or system camera) with full battery and enough memory. A telephoto focal length from 300mm and up and converters are necessary. A tripod - if available - is useful. Also a bean bag, knee protection or mat. An angle finder has already given good service. We take pictures in all weather conditions, especially in "bad" conditions special pictures may occur. Please therefore use outdoor clothing.

The guiding can be canceled at short notice, if at course time, contrary to expectations, no fledglings are present.
